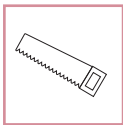


Cutting:

Cut using woodworking tools.



Powered saw



Hand saw

Breakages? Material chipping?

Cut slowly with a fine tooth blade, at room temperature.

Fixing:

Similar fixing to a wooden product.



Pinned

Warm product and use a very fine headless pin gun.



Screwed

Predrill and countersink hole. After fixing, apply wood filler to hole and sand smooth before finishing.



Glued

Virtually all glues – including panel adhesives, wood glues, super glues. Support items whilst curing and follow adhesive manufacturer's instructions.

Curved surface?

Strip mouldings can be gently warmed and applied to your curve. Thinner mouldings will flex more.

Finishing:

Types of finish:



Paint – Spray

All standard paints inc. wood, wall and specialist spray paints.



Paint – By hand

All standard brush applied paints inc. wood, wall and specialist paints.



Stain

Use solvent based stains. Particularly effective on mouldings that have woodgrain.

Benefits

- Better to finish than a wooden product.
- No/Minimal surface prep required.
Occasionally a light rub back with paint prep pads.
- No priming required – unless in more demanding applications where we recommend wood primer.
- No sealing required.
